

### Musical Synopsis

#### Act 1

Ren McCormack, a Chicago teenager, dances away his work stress at a club before revealing to friends he's moving to the small town of Bomont with his mother due to financial troubles. In Bomont, Ren and his mother attend church led by the strict minister Shaw Moore. After a sermon against "rock and roll," Moore's daughter Ariel sneaks off to see her boyfriend Chuck, but Moore arrives and catches them together, disapprovingly.

Ren's first day at school brings him face-to-face with Willard Hewitt, who initially confronts Ren but quickly becomes his friend. Ren shares that he's passionate about dancing, a hobby he brought with him from Chicago, and even breaks into dance at school, which provokes the principal because dancing is prohibited in Bomont. Willard stands up for Ren, explaining that he's new to town. Rusty commends Willard for defending Ren, then she and her friends inform Ren of the local law banning dancing—a rule put in place following a fatal accident involving the reverend's son. They caution Ren to stay out of the spotlight to avoid more trouble.

Ariel returns home but is ignored by Shaw, who is upset about her relationship with Chuck Cranston. After Ariel leaves in frustration, Moore and Vi argue about her, with Shaw dismissing Vi's reassurances before leaving to write his sermon. Ethel and Vi sympathize over the suspicion Ren faces as a newcomer, and when Ariel joins them, they share their frustrations about not being heard by others set in their ways.

After school, Ariel, Rusty, and friends do homework at Burger Blast while Ren works in a waiter's uniform and roller skates. Ariel flirts with Ren; Willard warns him about Chuck Cranston's jealousy. Ren asks Willard about Rusty, who he finds attractive but overly talkative. Ariel tells her friends she wants a decent guy. Chuck arrives angry and yells at Ariel, but Ren, Willard, and restaurant owner Betty Blast step in to stop the confrontation.

After Ren gets off work, Ariel takes him to her secret place beneath the train tracks where she discusses her hatred of Bomont. Unbeknownst to them, Chuck witnesses the pair together.

Ren walks Ariel home, surprising Moore and Vi who thought she was in her room. Shaw is displeased with Ariel's actions, and Ren accidentally offends him, prompting Shaw's friends to leave abruptly. Shaw orders Ariel to stop seeing Ren, but she protests, feeling imprisoned. After his daughter and wife leave angrily, Shaw feels guilty and questions whether he is being fair as both a preacher and a father.

Ren shows up late to gym class the next day with Ariel and Willard, explaining that Chuck attacked him, but their teacher pays no attention. Frustrated by Bomont's strict rules, Ren misses the lively dance clubs in Chicago. After Willard cracks a joke about dancing, Ren is inspired to suggest a school dance as a way to bring teens together and defy Moore's authority. Although Willard finds the plan outlandish, Ren presents his proposal to other students and gets them on board. Moore, who originally prohibited dancing, remains determined to prevent it from happening.

### Act 2

Ren, Ariel, Willard, and Rusty visit a nearby town's dance hall with a country band. Rusty wants to dance with Willard, but he avoids it and admits to Ren at the bar that he can't dance. After cowboys mock Willard, Rusty defends him and confesses her feelings. As Rusty sings, Ren teaches Willard to dance, and Willard impresses everyone with his newfound skills.

Chuck Cranston arrives at the Moores' home, making Vi and Shaw anxious when he says Ariel isn't where they expected. After Chuck leaves, Ariel returns, pretending to have been studying, but her parents confront her. An argument follows between Shaw and Ariel until Vi steps in and consoles Shaw, noting his reprimand isn't logical.

Ren, Willard, and their friends work on presenting their idea to the town council. Ren feels discouraged, but Willard encourages him not to give up. When Ariel arrives with a black eye from Chuck, Ren comforts her at the train station. Ariel reveals her brother's death led to the dancing ban and gives Ren a Bible with marked passages for his case. There, Ren and Ariel realize they love each other.

At the town council meeting, Ren argues that dancing is mentioned in the Bible and shouldn't be banned. Despite some support, the council rejects the motion.

After the meeting, Ethel tells Ren that Shaw's votes were assured and advises him to speak directly with Shaw. Ren visits the pastor, urging him not to let his grief affect the whole town. They argue but recognize their shared experience of loss. Ren leaves, and Moore is left reconsidering his position.

At the next service, Shaw announces that the teenagers can hold a dance, which excites them all. Ren asks Ariel, and Willard invites Rusty. After everyone leaves, Shaw admits past mistakes to Vi and expresses his love. Ultimately, Moore, his wife, and the townspeople attend the big dance.
